- can breathe in water

- no feathers
- sometimes fur
- gives babies milk
















- cold blooded

What animal am I? (extension game)

Cut out the boxes and give one to each child. Each box has the name of an animal and a list of its features. Ask the children to stick their animal on their forehead with masking tape and ask other children to answer questions about it. In this way the child gain clues about the animal they are wearing. You could give each child a copy of this sheet to help them.

<p><u>Sea turtle</u> Amphibian = cold blooded, no feathers, no fur</p>	<p><u>Dog</u> Mammal =warm blooded, no feathers, fur</p>	<p><u>Rabbit</u> Mammal =warm blooded, no feathers, fur</p>
<p><u>Dolphin</u> Mammal =warm blooded, no feathers, no fur</p>	<p><u>Woodlouse</u> Invertebrate =cold blooded, no feathers, no fur</p>	<p><u>Tarantula</u> Invertebrate =cold blooded, no feathers, fur</p>
